In "the other side of the room," Aldo Giannotti and Karin Pauer invite you to a multi-part series at Blickle Raum, blending the realms of visual art and choreography. This distinctive collaboration sets out to combine and challenge different artistic practices, with an emphasis on the intricate relationship between sculptural and performative elements. Integral to this exploration are artists Alex Franz Zehetbauer and Carolina Cappelli, alongside a diverse group of performers, choreographers, and musicians, all engaging with a sculptural intervention by Peter Sandbichler.

The series not only aims to illuminate the unique methodologies of these artists, but also to delve into the sculptural, visual, acoustic, performative, and conceptual synergies at play.
